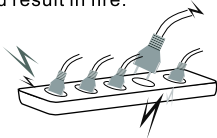
03. Make sure that the power supply is firmly plugged in and not loose. Failure to do so could result in electrical shock.

06. Disconnect the power supply during inclement weather conditions that include thunder and lightning. Failure to do so may result in fire.



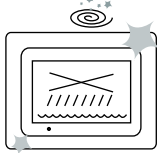

1. **RIGHT:** Move the cursor to right or down; increase volume when playing movie.
2. **LEFT:** Move the cursor to left or up; decrease volume when playing movie.
3. **ENTER:** Enter into the selected menu or start playing the selected file.
4. **EXIT:** Stop the current action and return to the previous menu.
5. **POWER:** Turn the player off and on .

6. **CF CARD SLOT:** Insert CF card here.
7. **MS/SD/MMC/XD CARD SLOT:** Insert supported memory card types here.

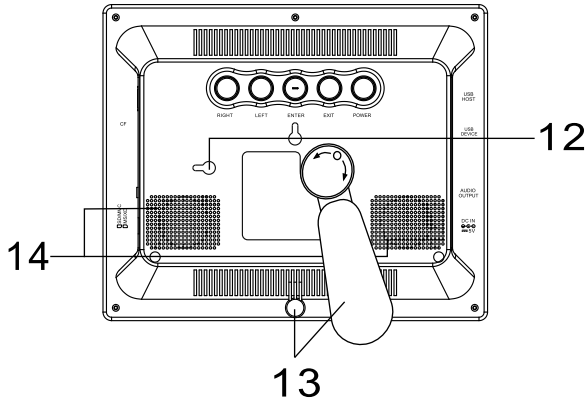

11. **DC IN :** Insert the DC power adapter to the frame.

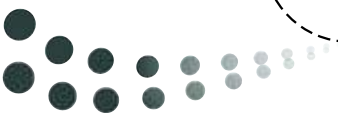

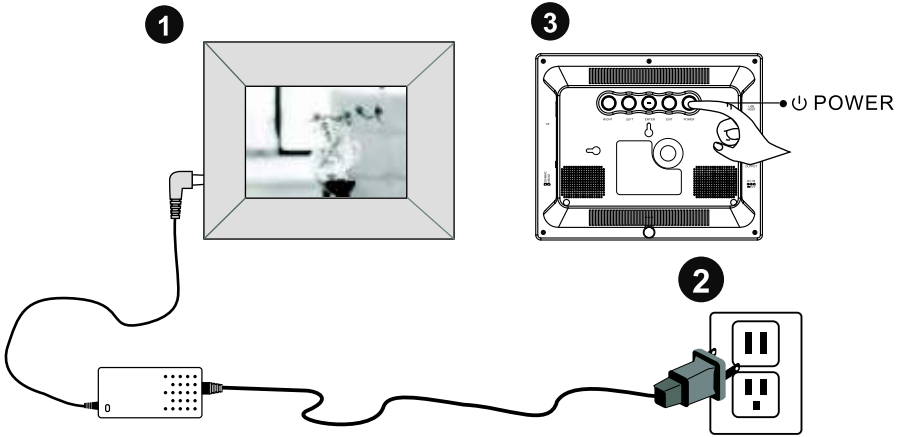

Power Connection



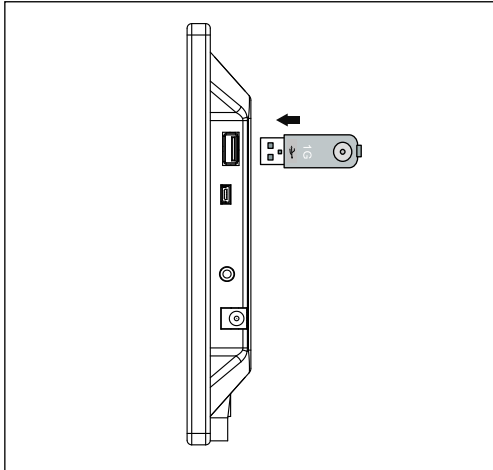
1. Connect the power adaptor to the DC 5V jack on the left side of the frame.
2. Plug in the power cord.
3. The frame will automatically power on.

USB Removable Storage Devices

Insert USB removable storage devices (ie: flash drives) into the USB HOST port on the side of the frame.



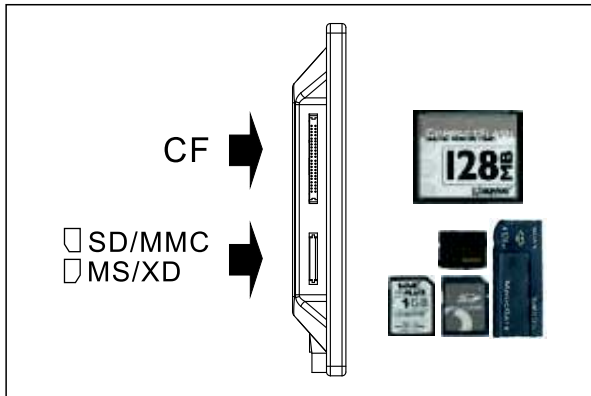

Memory Card Insertion

When inserting a memory card into the frame, refer to the image to make sure that both the memory card and the frame are aligned correctly (the side of the memory card on which sticker is affixed should face the frame).

CF, SD, Memory Stick, MMC cards, XD cards are compatible with this unit. Aligning the memory card upside down may cause user-error damage. This may nullify the warranty.

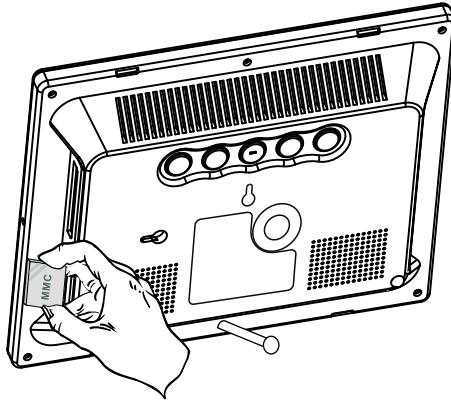


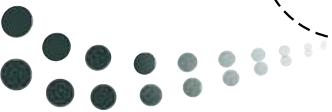

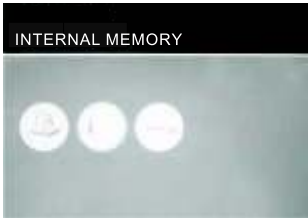

Photo

Locate the Device Directory

In the main menu, select the desired item (Internal Memory / Memory Card/Flash Drive) and touch it to enter the file list.



Step show pictures

Select the desired photo and touch it in the file list for a preview of the picture on the left side of the screen. Touch the preview of the photo on the screen to enter the step show mode



Previous pictures

In the step show mode, touch the  to skip to the previous picture and keep interface.

Next pictures

In the step show mode, touch the  to skip to the next picture and keep interface.

Rotate

In the step show mode, touch  repeatedly to rotate the picture anticlockwise.

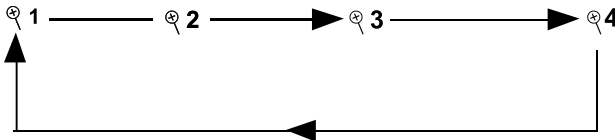

During photo playback, touch  repeatedly will magnify the image in the following sequence:



Background Music

In the step show mode, touch  to play background music, touch  or  to increase or decrease the volume; touch  to mute the volume.

Note: To utilize this feature you must have picture files (JPG, BMP, PNG, TIFF) and music files saved to the same file source (ie: Internal Memory/Memory Card/Flash Drive).

EXIT

In the step show mode, touch  to return to the previous menu.

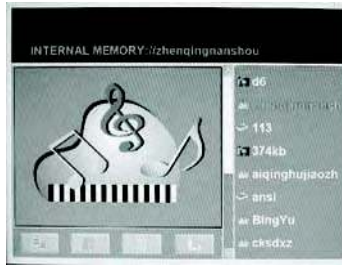

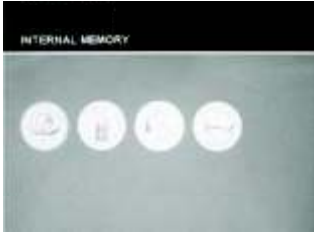

Editing Files



In the main menu, select the desired device (Internal Memory/Memory Card/Flash Drive) and touch the corresponding icon to enter its file list.



A. Copy and Paste Files

Touch  to highlight the select item, touch the file items in file list to choose the files to be copied, and the color of the selected file will turn red.




Touch  to return to the parent directory, select the device or folder you want to transfer the files to. Touch  to start transferring the files. You will see the following screen:

B: Delete Files

Touch  and highlight the files in the file list to be deleted.



Touch  to delete the files selected.

In the main menu, touch **SETTINGS** to enter the setup menu.

1. Change Slide Show Intervals

In the **SETTINGS** menu, touch **SLIDE SHOW** to access the following choices:



Touch and set the interval time of slide to 5s/10s/15s.



EXIT

Touch **EXIT** to return to the previous menu.

2. Slide show mode

In the SETTINGS menu, touch slide show mode to access, the screen will display as below:



Touch the corresponding item to set your picture transition effect. You may choose between top to bottom wipe, left to right wipe, randomized wipe etc.

3.Display

In the SETTINGS menu, touch display to access, the screen will display as below :



Touch Optimal to display the picture in full screen when in slideshow mode, there is no black edge; Touch Original to display the picture by its original rate when in slideshow mode, there may be one black edge on the top and the bottom or the left and the right of the screen.

EXIT

Touch EXIT to return to the previous menu.

4.Others

In the SETTINGS menu, touch others to access, the screen will display as below :

Default

Touch the default item to reset the system to its factory default settings.

EXIT

Touch EXIT to return to the previous menu.

Note: When the touch panel is invalid, please calibrate the screen.

Screen calibration

In the main menu, press the RIGHT button on panel board to select the SETTINGS icon, then press ENTER button on the panel board to access the below menu:



Press the RIGHT button on the panel board to select others item, and press ENTER button to enter into the next menu. Continuously press the RIGHT button on the panel board for five times to access the below menu:

Press the RIGHT button on the panel board to select screen calibration, then press ENTER button on the panel board to access the below menu:



A "+" will appear on the left up corner, touch the center of the "+"; then, the "+" will move to the right up corner of the screen, touch it again, the "+" will move to right down corner, left down corner and center of the screen in the order, touch it in order. Now, you finish the calibration.

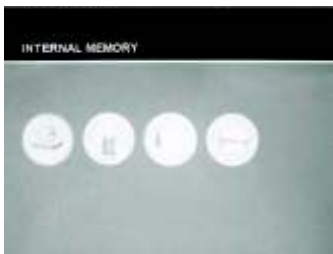
Note: When you touch the "+", please try to touch it as quickly as possible, it may be taken as two times touch, the "+" will not appear in order. If it happens, please start the calibration again.

EXIT

After calibrating screen, the frame will return to the previous menu.

Calendar & Clock

In the main menu, select CALENDAR & CLOCK device and touch it to enter the CALENDAR/ CLOCK screen.

Viewing the Calendar and Clock

In the CALENDAR/CLOCK menu, touch "right arrow" or "left arrow" on the top left box to set the year and press "right arrow" or "left arrow" in the second box to set the month.




Calendar/Clock Settings

In the CALENDAR/CLOCK screen, touch  to enter the CALENDAR /CLOCK SETTINGS screen.



CALENDAR SETTINGS


Touch the "left arrow" or "right arrow" of the first box to set the year. Touch "left arrow" or "right arrow" of the second box to set the month. Touch the date item to set the date. Touch  under the date table to save the new settings.

Clock settings


Touch "up arrow" or "down arrow" of the first box under CLOCK (HH:MM) to set the hour. Touch "up arrow" or "down arrow" of the second box to set the minute. Touch  to save the new settings.

Alarm settings

Touch the "left arrow" or "right arrow" of the first box under the ALARM (HH:MM) item to switch the alarm to off or on. Touch the "up arrow" or "down arrow" of the second box under the ALARM(HH:MM) item to set the hour of the alarm. Touch the "up arrow" or "down arrow" of the third box under the ALARM(HH:MM) item to set the minute of the alarm. Touch  to save the new settings.



Exit

Touch  to return to the previous menu .

Alarm

When it is the time to alarm, the screen will display as below:

Note: While connecting the frame to PC, please make sure the frame is in main menu and don't operation the frame.

ASSP is used to manage the file in the Internal Memory of the frame, it can switch the resolution of the photo higher than 800x600 to 800X600(at least the width is 800 or the height is 600) photos and delete the photos.

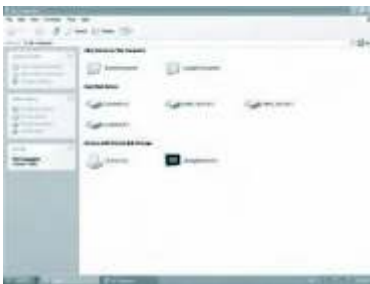
How to start ASSP

When connect the frame to your PC, there are several ways to start ASSP.

1.If your PC have started the auto-play function ,the following screen will appear ,select the item Image Viewer, press OK to confirm .



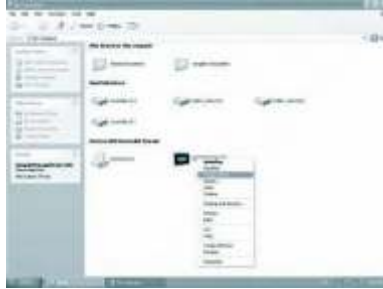
2.Select the corresponding removable disk "Internal Memory" for the internal memory of the frame.

3. Click the disk “Internal Memory” to access it , select the file named “ Image Viewer” .



4. Double click the file named “ImageViewer.exe”

Remarks: Some of the PC installed the Anti-Virus or the other Holding Up Software, they will make the “autorun.inf” invalid. In this situation, the file is hidden file, please set your PC to display all hidden files.

- A) While selecting different photos in the file list, the preview photo and information will display on the right of the window. (Width, Height and Size).
- B) Total Size and Free Size will also display.
- C) Click "Resize" to convert the photo size to 800x600(Pixel) and save as JPG format.
- D) Click "Delete" to delete the files in the address column.
- E) Click "Add Image" to add the photos from your PC to the current directory, or you can directly draw the desired file to the file list, the photos size will convert to 800x600(Pixel) automatically.

What photo and music formats are supported by the Photo Frame?	Photo: JPG, BMP, PNG, TIFF Music Movie: MPEG-4(avi) E-Book: txt
Can I set up the alarm ?	Yes , you can set up the alarm in the submenu of CALENDAR & CLOCK .
Why player does not display picture quickly after inserting memory card?	If your picture is high quality, please wait a minute. Or switch your picture by using the ASSP tool.
Can I insert multiple memory cards?	Yes, you can insert one of SD, MMC, MS,XD and CF at the same time.
Why picture does not cover the entire screen?	The picture whose rate is 4:3 and resolution is 800(RGB)x600 or higher than 800(RGB)x600 can cover the entire screen.
What is the best Picture resolution displayed on the screen?	The frame's best resolution is 800(RGB)x600.
Why won't it advance to next picture?	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. There is only one picture in the frame. 2. You are viewing high-resolution pictures in the card, High-resolution pictures can take some time to display. Please switch your picture by ASSP tool, if you want to display the picture quickly. 3.The frame is in step show mode, please touch the SLIDESHOW item on the screen to enter into slideshow mode. 4. The next picture has been corrupted.
Can I rotate a picture on the screen?	Yes. During step show mode, touch the ROTATE item to rotate the photo anticlockwise. Note: The rotated picture will return to its original orientation after you power down the digital frame.
Why Digital Photo Frame does not play movie?	In order to smooth video playback, the resolution 640x480 is recommended. It is best to restore the movie into the frame.
Why Digital Photo Frame does not read E-Book?	The frame only can read the ansi format TXT file.
Why the touch panel does not work?	Please see the screen calibration of the SETTINGS.

Troubleshooting

Some simple checks or a minor adjustment eliminate common problems:

No power

1. Check the power button is on.
2. Check the power outlet is operational.
3. Check the power cord for damages
4. Check the power plug is firmly connected to photo frame.

Can not read the card

1. Check the card for damages.
2. Check the card is connected yo the photo frame correctly.
3. Pull out the card, and then insert again.

Photo Frame is not working

Turn off the power, and then turn it on again.

The remote control is not working:

1. Check that the battery is properly installed.
2. Check that the battery “protective plastic” is pulled out.
