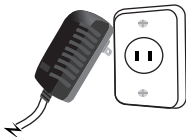
01. Use only the authorized power supply product. Failure to do so could result in product malfunction.



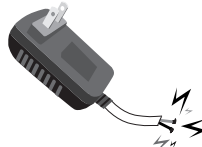
02. When connecting the power source, make sure that your hands are free of moisture. Failure to do so could result in electrical shock.



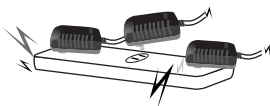
03. Make sure that the power supply is firmly plugged in and not loose. Failure to do so could result in electrical shock.

06. Disconnect the power supply during inclement weather conditions that include thunder and lightning. Failure to do so could result in fire.

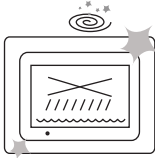

Product Related

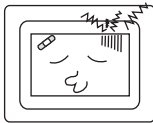
01. Dropping the product or subjecting it to a significant impact can cause critical damage.



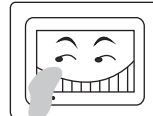
02. Spilling water or any other liquid on the product can cause critical damage.



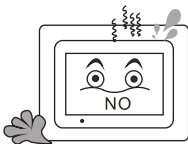
03. Striking or scratching the LCD screen may cause critical damage.



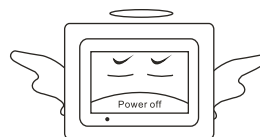
04. When cleaning the LCD screen, turn off the power and wipe it gently with a soft cloth.

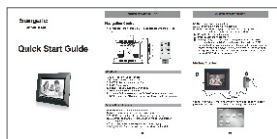

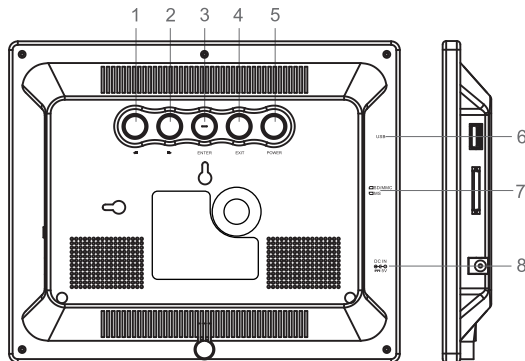

Navigation controls

The components may differ slightly in appearance with the provided images.



MEANING:

1. ◀ : Press to move cursor right.
2. ▶ : Press to move cursor left.
3. **ENTER**: Press to enter or confirm.
4. **EXIT**: Press to exit.
5. **Power**: Press to turn the unit off or on.
6. **USB**: Insert a USB flash disk.
7. **SD/MMC/MS**: Insert one of the SD/MMC/MS cards each time.
8. **DC IN**: Insert the AC adapter to connect the unit with power outlet.

Navigation controls



Remote Control function:

POWER: Press to turn the unit on or off.

SOURCE: Press to exit to the main menu directly.

SETUP: Press to set up picture display effect and mode, etc.

MODE: Press to change picture slideshow mode to Optimal or Original.

ROTATE: Press to rotate the picture which is playing.

▲/▼/◀/▶: Press to move cursor up, down, left or right

ENTER: Press to enter or confirm.

ZOOM: Zoom the picture which is playing.

PLAY/PAUSE: When playing a picture in full screen, press this button to pause or continue slideshow.

◀◀: Press to play the last picture.

▶▶: Press to play the next picture.

■: When playing pictures in full screen, press this button to exit to thumbnail pictures list. (Except the condition that your DPF automatically slideshow pictures in the internal memory while no memory card was inserted. At this time, no matter which buttons except POWER and SETUP buttons on remote control that you pressed, DPF will go to main menu.)

Getting started



Connecting your DPF machine with power by using the power adapter provided. The DPF machine will start up and go to main menu.



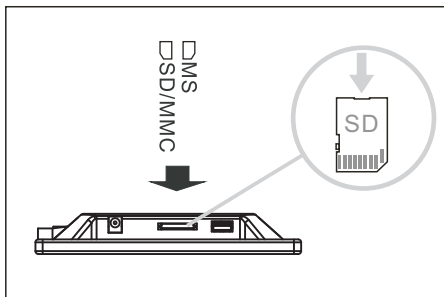
After about 10 seconds without any operation, the DPF machine will auto slideshow pictures in the internal memory.

Press  to the main menu.

Insert a memory card

Insert card in the direction indicated by the arrow on the top of the card.

SD, Memory Stick, MMC cards are compatible with this unit.
Aligning the memory card upside down may cause user-error damage.
This may nullify the warranty.

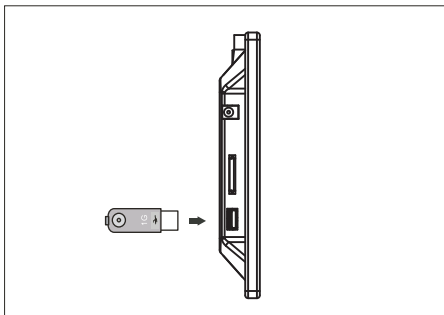


Removing the Memory Card

When removing a memory card from the frame, pull the card straight away from the unit. Avoid bending the card.

USB Removable Storage Devices

Insert USB removable storage device into the USB port on the side of the frame.

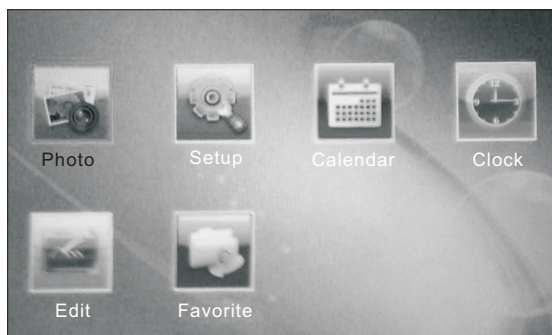


NOTE: This device will read USB first and will not recognise the memory card if you insert a memory card and extra USB memory together at the same time.

Photos

Display Photos

In the main menu, press ◀ / ▶ on remote control to move cursor to the first icon “Photo” and then press ENTER to display photos.



(Main menu)

Note: If you have inserted USB device and memory card at the same time, the frame will display pictures in the USB device first, then display pictures in the memory card unless you have pull out the USB device.

When playing, press to play the last picture or next picture.

Press ◀ / ▶ or ROTATE to rotate pictures

Press ZOOM button to zoom pictures

Press MODE to change picture view ratio between optimal mode and original mode.

Press ENTER or PLAY/PAUSE to pause slideshow or continue slideshow.

When slideshow pictures, press ● to enter the thumbnail mode, there will be two icons “Rotate” and “Slide Show” listed at the right down corner of the screen.

Keep pressing ▼ to move cursor to “Rotate” and press ENTER to confirm, then the cursor will auto go back to the thumbnail pictures, you can keep pressing ▲ / ▼ / ◀ / ▶ and then ENTER to rotate pictures.

If you want to restore all of the rotated the pictures, keep pressing ▼ to move cursor to “Reset” and press ENTER to confirm, then all of the rotated pictures will be restored to normal angle. Press ▶ to move cursor to “Return” and press ENTER to return.

Press SOURCE on remote control to the main menu directly.

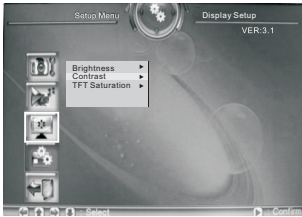
Setup

Press SETUP on remote control to go to setup interface directly or you can also press **▲/▼/◀/▶** to move cursor to the second icon “Setup” in the main menu and press ENTER to enter the setup menu.

In the setup menu,

Moving to Desired Setting item and Changing Settings

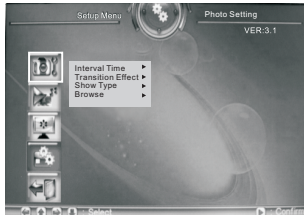
1. Press the **▲** button to select items
2. Press the **▶** button to enter the setting item list.
3. Press **▲** or **▼** buttons to select desired setting items.
4. Press OK to change setting.



You can press the **◀** button to back to the previous item, and press the EXIT button to back to the main menu.

Setup Menu-Photo Setting



Interval Time

In the setup menu, select Setup Menu-Photo Setting. Then select the Interval Time to set the desired time that make the image remains on the screen in slide show mode.

Transition Effect

In the setup menu, select Setup Menu-Photo Setting. Then select the Interval Effect to set the desired transfer effect in slide show mode.

Show Type

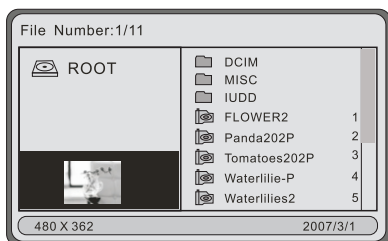
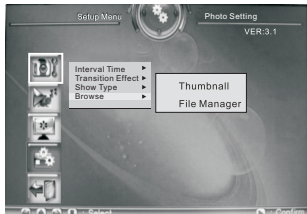
In the setup menu, select Setup Menu- Photo Setting. Then select the Show Type to set the desired photo displaying type.
Select Fit Screen to display images fit to screen in slide show mode;
and select Full Screen to display entire images in slide show mode.

Browse

In the setup menu, select Setup Menu-Photo Setting. Then select the Browse to set the desired browse mode.

Set the Browse (Thumbnail / File manager) mode to pre-view photos in different mode.

Setup Menu- Auto - Play

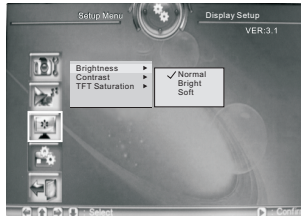
Photo

In the setup menu, select Setup Menu-Auto-Play. Then select the Photo to set the photo displaying auto or manual.

1. Set the photo auto play to ON: It will auto display the photos in slide show mode.
2. Set the photo auto play to OFF: For manual play.

Setup Menu- Display Setup



Brightness

In the setup menu, select Setup Menu-Display Setup. Then select the Brightness to adjust the displaying brightness.

Select the Normal / Bright / Soft to adjust display

Contrast

In the setup menu, select Setup Menu-Display Setup. Then select the Contrast to adjust the displaying contrast.

TFT Saturation

In the setup menu, select Setup Menu-Display Setup. Then select the TFT Saturation to adjust the TFT saturation.

Setup Menu - Custom Setup

OSD Language

In the setup menu, select Setup Menu-Custom Setup. Then select the OSD Language to select different language.

Note: For this product, the OSD language include English, French and Spanish.

Repeat mode

In the setup menu, select Setup Menu-Custom Setup. Then select the Repeat mode to change the Setup Menu interface color.

Select One to repeat current track.

Select Folder to repeat current folder

Select All to repeat current memory card/disk

Select Off to cancel the repeat mode.

Default

In the setup menu, select Setup Menu-Custom Setup. Then select the Default to reset the unit to factory default.

Exit

In the setup menu, select Setup Menu-Custom Setup. Then select the Exit to finish the setup menu to go back to the main menu.

Calendar and Clock

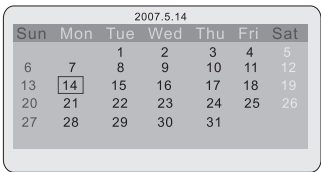
Calendar

In the main menu, press **▲**/**▼**/**◀**/**▶** to move cursor to Calendar and press ENTER to enter the interface with 3 options: Display, Set Date, Exit
Press ENTER to display calendar.

Move cursor to “Set Date” and press ENTER, then press **▲**/**▼**/**◀**/**▶** and ENTER to set up date.

Finally move cursor to OK and press ENTER to confirm.

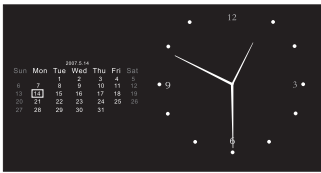
Choose “Exit” and press ENTER to the main menu.



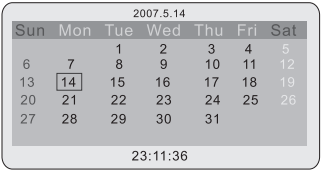

Clock

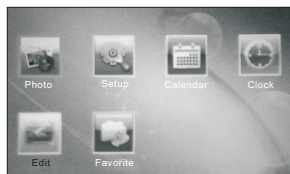
In the main menu, press **▲**/**▼**/**◀**/**▶** to move cursor to Clock and press ENTER to enter the interface with 3 options: Display, Set Time, Exit
Press ENTER and then **▲**/**▼** to choose display digital clock or analogue clock or clock with calendar

Move the cursor to “Set Time” and press ENTER, then press **▲**/**▼**/**◀**/**▶** and ENTER to set up time.

Finally move cursor to OK and press ENTER to confirm.

Edit

Note: Adding the pictures from external memory to the digital photo frame, or deleting the pictures stored in the digital photo frame. So please insert a external device such as USB or memory card into the frame first if you want copy pictures to the digital photo frame.



Copy

Step 1. Select Edit icon in the main menu, and press ENTER to display the Edit Dilaog.

Step 2. Select Copy icon and press ENTER to enter into the file list.

Step 3. Use the navigation buttons to select the desired images, and press ENTER to confirm. To copy more, continue select images and confirm.

Note: As internal memory space is limited, so you can save maybe no more than 8 photos in the internal memory.

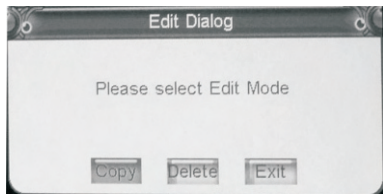
Step 4. Press the ◀ or ▶ to move the cursor to the Save icon, and press ENTER to begin copy the images.

Step 5. After saving, select the Exit icon to return to the main menu.

Edit

Delete

Note: Pictures deleted cannot be recovered. Think over before you confirm to delete.



Step 1. Select Edit icon in the main menu, and press ENTER to display the Edit Dialog.

Step 2. Select Delete icon and press ENTER to enter into the file list.

Step 3. Press ▼ button to select Delete icon and press ENTER to back to the images.

Step 4. Press navigation buttons to select the image you prefer to delete, press ENTER to delete. Continue selecting images and press ENTER to delete more.

Step 5. Press the navigation buttons to select the Return icon to back of Edit Mode.

Press **SOURCE** to the main menu.

Note: You can only delete pictures stored in the internal memory of the digital photo frame by operating like this. If you want to delete pictures in the memory card or USB device, please delete through computer.

Favorite

Favorite

In the main menu, press ▲ / ▼ / ◀ / ▶ buttons to move cursor to Favorite icon and press ENTER to slideshow pictures stored in the internal memory of your digital photo frame.

Question & Answer

This chapter will attempt to troubleshoot common problems that one may experience with the Multimedia DPF. If this guide does not solve your problem, do not dismantle the machine yourself.

Question	Answer
What is the main function of the digital photo frame?	Using the digital photo frame,you can display images,calender and clock.
Dose Digital Photo Frame have built-in memory?	Yes.The player has an internal memory to store 8 photos. Do not rename the memory's name.
What memory card are compatible with the digital photo frame?	The unit can be compatible with SD/MMC/MS card.
Why picture display seems slow?	You are viewing high-resolution pictures,it can take some time to display..
Why the unit can't display pictures?	Make sure the pictures are in JPEG format. Make sure you have inserted a card or USB device properly and selected the PHOTO icon in the main menu. or make sure there are pictures in the internal memory and you have selected the FAVORITE icon in the main menu.
How can I see the file list?	Please set Browse item in Setup Menu to File Manger mode.

Troubleshooting

Some simple checks or a minor adjustment eliminate common problems:

No power

1. Check the power button is on.
2. Check the power outlet is operational.
3. Check the power cord for damages.
4. Check the power plug is firmly connected to photo frame.

Can not read the card

1. Check the card for damages.
2. Check the card is connected the photo frame correctly.
3. Pull out the card, and then insert again.

Photo Frame is not working

Trun off the power, and then turn it on again.
