




Basic Features





Main Features and Basic Operations

Front Side

- **1.** Press the Directional Keys to move the index to up/down/left/right.
- 2. Press OK to confirm or enter, play or pause.
- 3. Press EXIT to exit and back to the previous menu
- 4. : Page up/page down/page previous/page next

UP Side

5. OFF POWER ON: Slide the button to left/right to turn on/off the PDA

Right Side

- **6. PHONE:** Insert for earphone use.
- 7. USB: Manage your files in the frame by connecting the USB cable to a PC
- 8. DC IN: Insert the DC power adaptor to the PDA player

Under Side

9. SD/MMC/MS: Insert SD/MMC/MS card.

UP Side

- 10. Press TXT to enter the E-book reading screen
- 11. Press MOVIE to enter the video file list.
- **12.** Press MUSIC to start listening to songs.
- 13. Press PHOTO to start a slide show of pictures.

Power Connection

Power Connection




- 1. Connect the power adapter to the DC IN 5V jack on the DPA
- 2. Plug the AC Adapter to a power jack to supply power to the DPA and charge for the built-in battery.

Note: Don't turn off the unit when the battery is charging.

PC Connecting

Connecting your DPA to your PC Use the supplied USB cable to connect your DPA to your PC.



Note: The ASSP is a software in the internal memory developed by Sungale go manage the picture and audio files to optimize the utilization of the source of the memory. The ASSP is inapplicable to manage ebook and video files. Just use the unit as a regular storage device to manage ebook and video files after connecting the unit to the PC.

Start ASSP

- 1. Use the supplied USB cable to connect your PDA to your PC.
- 2. Click "My computer" on your computer
- 3. Click "Storage Device Disk"
- 4. Double click Fileconverter exe and enter into the ASSP interface.
- Tip: 1. If your PC has set as auto-run, you will enter into the ASSP interface directly, no operation needed.
 - 2. The PC installed the anti-virus software or other hold-up software will make the "autorun.inf" invalid. In this situation, the file is set as hidden file. If you want to autorun the ASSP, you can set your PC to display hidden files.

PC Connecting

Use ASSP

- 1. Click"Add File" and find the desired files you want to add to your PDA from your computer.
- 2. Doubel click the file, and the file will be automatically stored in your PDA.
- 3. When you finish the operation, safely remove the USB cable from your PC.


In this way, the photos downloaded will be stored at 320X240 to suit your DPA's screen and the MP3 files will be transferred into WMA file.



Tip: You also can take the DPA as a regular storage device, select the photos from your computer, then paste them in the DPA's internal memory. In this way, the photos will be stored without compression. If you want to optimize your internal memory, you can select the photos, then click the "Convert".

Attention: Once you format the internal memory of your DPA, the ASSP software will be deleted.

In this situation, you can still use the DPA as a regular storage device, and copy, paste, delete files after connecting your DPA to the PC,

Viewing photos in Full screen

Slide Show Mode

Tip I: Press the shortcut button "PHOTO" on the top of the album, the default display is in slide show mode.

Tip II: From the main menu, press direction keys to select the Photo icon, press OK to view the photos in slide show mode.







Step Show Mode

In the default slide show mode, press OK to pause the slide show, then press \S for step show mode.

Display a Photo

- 1. During photo playback, press EXIT to enter into the thumbnail mode.
- 2. Press k momently to skip to the next or previous page and select the desired photo.
- 3. Press OK to display the photo in full screen.

Photo

Playing/Pausing the photo

During photo playback, press OK to play/pause playing the photos.

Copy the photo

- 1. Insert the memory card and the screen will display "Card in".
- 2. Select Photo icon from the main menu and press OK.
- 3. Select Memory Card and press OK to start the photo slide show on the Memory Card.
- 4. Press OK to stop on the photo desired to be copied.
- 5. Press A to copy the photo to the Internal Memory.

Rotate the photo

In photo step show mode, press $\langle \rangle$ to rotate the photo.

Silde show in music background

- Tip1: In photo slide show mode, press the short cut button MUSIC to start a slide show in music background.
- Tip2:During music playing back, press the shortcut button PHOTO to start a slide show in music background.
- Note: when displaying photos in music background, hold on A / ▼ around OK button to adjust the volume.
 - You can only listen to the music by wearing the earphone.

Music

Locate the Music Directory

- I: Press the shortcut button "MUSIC" to start listening to songs directly.
- II: From the main menu, press ✓ or ➤ to select the Music icon and press OK to enter the music directory.





Selecting a music

Press A or v to select the desired music file, press OK to play.

Playing/Pausing the music

During play back ,press OK button .

Adjusting the volume

During music playback, hold ★ to increase the volume, hold ¥ to decrease the volume.

Music EQ mode/Circle mode

During music playback, press ➤ momently to select the EQ mode; press < to enter the Circle mode to play the music circularly.

Movie

Select the Device Directory

I: Press the shortcut button "MOVIE" on the top of the album to enter the video file list.

II; From the main menu, press direction keys to select the Movie icon and press OK to enter the movie list.





Selecting and Playing Movies

Press ▲ / ▼ to select the desired movie and press OK to play the movie file.



Adjust the volume

During movie playback, hold ▲ /▼ to increase or decrease the volume.

Note: Only AVI formatted video files with bit rate under 30fps can be played.

E-Book

Note: This album is only compatible with TXT formatted text.

- I: Press the shortcut button "TXT" on the top of the albumto enter the E-book reading screen.
- II: From the main menu, press direction keys to select the E-Book icon, press OK to enter the E-book file list.



Select the desired file from the different folder (Last Read/Main Directory) and press OK to enter the TXT book reading screen .



E-Book

Previous/Next page

Press A to go to the previous page, press to go to the next page.



In the TXT format E-Book reading screen, the default reading mode is Manual Mode, Press OK to change to the Auto Mode, press ∢ / ➤ change the Reading interval (5s/10s/15s/30s/45s/60s). If you want to save the current reading page, you should press FXIT to exit to the main menu.

Reading in music background

During music playing back, press the shortcut button TXT to read a book in music background.

Setup

Setup

From the main menu, press direction keys to select Setup icon , press OK to enter the setup menu.





Brightness

From the setup menu, press \forall or \land to select Brightness, press \prec or \succ to set the brightness for 1/2/3/4/5.

Auto off

From the setup menu, press ✓ or ★ to select Close Time, press ✓ or ➤ to set the close time for 0 Min-----120 Min.

When turned off the unit automatically, hold on the OK button to turn it on again.

Setup

Slide Time

From the setup menu, press y or A to select Slide Time, press ≺ or ➤ to set slide show time to (5 Sec/15Sec/30Sec/1 Min/60 Min).

Slide Mode

From the setup menu, press y or A to select Slide Mode, press ≺ or ➤ to set slide show effect to (Random/Left to Right/Right to Left/Top left Bottom right/Zoom Out /Vexpand Middle/Door Open/Blind Horizontal/Blind Vertical).

Repeat Mode

From the setup menu, press y or ∧ to select Repeat Mode, press < or > to set repeat mode to (Repeat Off/Repeat Folder/Repeat All).

Default

From the setup menu, press ▼ or A to select Default ,then press OK to return to the default settings.

Question	Answer
What photo, music and video formats are supported by this Multi-media Digital Photo Album?	Photo: JPEG BMP Music: WMA(Auto transfer Mp3) Video: AVI (bit rate under 30fps)
Does the player have a built-in memory?	Yes. The player has an internal memory to store media files . Do not rename the memory's name.
Why the internal memory appeared less than 512 MB on my computer?	The operation software occupied a small part of the memory.
Can I insert multiple memory cards?	Yes, you can insert one of SD,MMC, MS card each time.
Why doesn't the picture cover the entire screen?	The resolution of the picture to cover the entire screen must be greater than 320x240 pixels.
Can the DPA player connect with all computers?	No. The USB port of the PC must be USB 2.0 and the PC must have Windows 2000 or above.
Why couldn't I hear the music when I press the Music Button?	You must load the music file before listen to it. You can only listen to the music by wearing the earphone.
