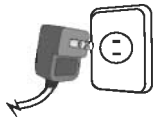
02. When connecting your Digital Photo Frame to a power source, make sure that your hands and feet are free of moisture. Failure to do so could result in electric shock.

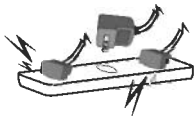
03. Make sure that the power supply is firmly plugged in and not loose. Failure to do so could result in electrical shock.

### Product Related

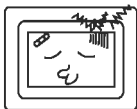
01. Dropping the product, or subjecting it to a jolting impact can cause critical damage to the unit.

03. Striking or scratching the LCD screen may cause permanent damage to the screen.



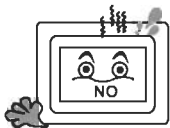
04. When cleaning the LCD screen, unplug the unit and wipe it gently with a soft cloth.



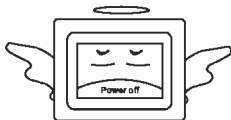

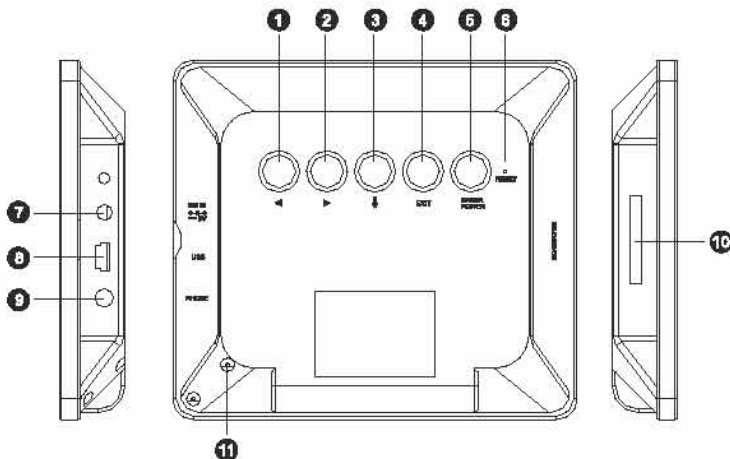

## Main Features and Basic Operations

### Rear Side

1. ◀ : Press to move to the previous chapter.
2. ▶ : Press to move to the next chapter.
3. ↓ : In the main menu screen , press to shift between the device and card icons.  
In the photo browse mode , press the button momentarily to skip to the next page ,  
hold to skip the previous menu.
- 4.EXIT : Press to exit the current page.
- 5.ENTER/POWER : Hold the button to turn on/off the DPF , press the button momentarily to  
enter/confirm.
6. RESET : Use a thin stick to insert to the hole and press to reset your DPF.

### Left Side

- 7.DC IN: Insert the DC power adaptor to the DPF player .
- 8.USB Device: Connect to the USB cable from the DPF to PC.
9. PHONE: Insert for earphone use.

### Right Side

- 10.SD/MMC/MS: Insert SD/MMC/MS card.

### Rear Side

11. Stand: Using the stand provided to stand the player horizontal.

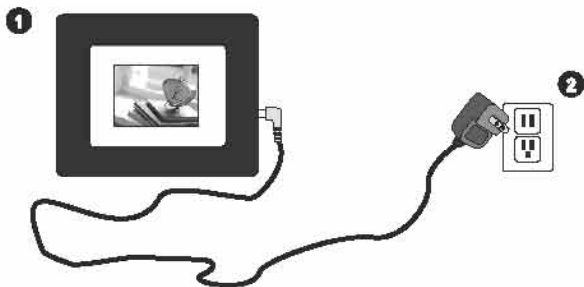

### Power Connection



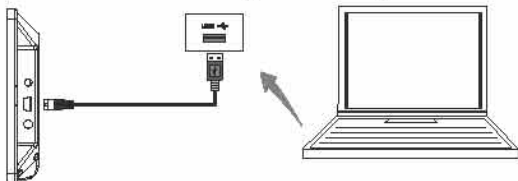
1. Connect the power adapter to the DC IN 5V Jack on the DPF
2. Plug the AC Adapter to a power jack to supply power to the DPF and charge for the built-in battery.

**Note:** If there is power in the built-in battery, you can use the player directly.

## PC Connecting

### Connecting your DPF to your PC

Use the supplied USB cable to connect your DPF to your PC.



1. After connecting your DPF to the PC, your PC should display a window similar to the one shown below.
2. Choose "Open folder to view files..." and click "OK". Your PC will display the contents of your memory.
3. With your DPF files on display, you may copy documents and move them to your PC, delete items from your DPF's memory, or paste files on your PC into your DPF's memory. Right click the desired items to find these options.
4. When you are finished managing your files, click the "Safely Remove Hardware" icon on your toolbar and confirm the operation.
5. When your PC says you may remove your hardware, unplug the USB cable from your PC, and resume use of your DPF.

## Photo

### Viewing photos in Full screen

From the main menu, press ► or ◀ to select the Photo icon , press ENTER to view the photos in slide show mode.



### Viewing a photo in multi-screen

During photo playback, press EXIT to preview the photos in multi-screen, press ► or ◀ to select the previous or next photo . In the photo browse mode , press ↓ momentarily to skip to the next page ,hold to skip the previous page.



## Photo

### **Playing/Pausing the photo**

During photo playback, press **ENTER** to play/pause playing the photos.

### **Copy the photo**

After inserted the memory card , the screen will display “ **CARD IN** “. Select the desired card Icon from the main menu , press **ENTER** to enter the card screen. Select the Photo icon and press **ENTER** . In photo step show mode, select the photo to be copied, press **↓** to copy the photo to internal memory.

**Note:** You can only copy the photos from your memory cards to the internal memory of your DPF.

# Music

## Music

### Locate the Music Directory

From the main menu, press **▶** or **◀** to select the Music icon and press **ENTER** to enter the music directory .



### Selecting a music

Press **▶** or **◀** to select the desired music file , press **ENTER** to play.

### Playing/Pausing the music

During play back ,press **ENTER** button .

### Adjusting the volume

During music playback, press **▶** to turn up the volume, press **◀** to turn down the volume.

### Music EQ mode/Circle mode

During music playback, press **↓** momentarily to turn enter the EQ mode; hold the button to enter the Circle mode to play the music circularly.

# Movie

## Movie

### Select the Device Directory

From the main menu, press ► or ◀ to select the **Movie** icon and press ENTER to enter the movie list .



### Selecting and Playing Movies

Press ► or ◀ to select the desired movie and press ENTER to play the movie file.



**Note :** Only AVI formatted video files with bit rate under 30fps can be played.

### E-Book

**Note :** This frame is only compatible with TXT formatted text .  
From the main menu, press ► or ◀ to select the E-Book icon, press ENTER to enter the E-book file list .



## E-Book

Select the desired file from the different folder (Last Read/Main Directory) and press ENTER to enter the TXT book reading screen .



Press ◀ to go to the previous row, press ▶ to go to the next row ; Hold ↓ to go to the previous page, hold ↵ to go to the next page.



In the TXT format E-Book reading screen, the default reading mode is Manual Mode, Press ENTER to change to the Auto Mode, press ↓ to change the Reading interval (5s/10s/15s/30s/45s/60s).If you want to save the current reading page , you should press EXIT to exit to the main menu.

## Calendar

### Calendar

From the main menu, press ► or ◀ to select Calendar icon , press ENTER to enter the calendar screen .



Press ► to go to the next day, press ◀ to go to the former day.

Press ↓ momentarily to go to the next month; hold the button to go the former month.

Press ENTER to set for the current date .

## Setup

### Setup

From the main menu, press ► or ◀ to select Setup icon , press ENTER to enter the setup menu.



### Language

From the setup menu, press ↓ to select Language , the only display language is English.

### Brightness

From the setup menu, press ↓ to select Brightness, press ► or ◀ to set the brightness for 1/2/3/4/5, press EXIT to save the setting.

### Auto off

From the setup menu, press ↓ to select Close Time, press ► or ◀ to set the close time for 0 Min-----120 Min, press EXIT to save the setting.



### **Current hour**

From the setup menu, press ↓ to select current hour, press ► or ◀ to set the current hour for 0 hour----23hour , press EXIT to save the setting.

### **Current minute**

From the setup menu, press ↓ to select Current minute, press ► or ◀ to set the current minute for 0 Min----59 Min , press EXIT to save the setting.

### **Slide Time**

From the setup menu, press ↓ to select Slide Time , press ► or ◀ to set slide show time to (5 Sec/15Sec /30Sec/1 Min/60 Min) ,press EXIT to save the setting.

### **Slide Mode**

From the setup menu, press ↓ to select Slide Mode , press ► or ◀ to set slide show effect to (Random/Left\_to\_Right/Right\_to\_Left/ Top left\_ Bottom right/Zoom Out /Vexpand\_Middle/Door\_Open/Blind Horizontal/Blind Vertical), press EXIT to save the setting.

### **Repeat Mode**

From the setup menu, press ↓ to select Repeat Mode , press ► or ◀ to set repeat mode to (Repeat Off/Repeat Folder/Repeat All) ,press EXIT to save the setting.

### **Default**

From the setup menu, press ↓ to select Default , press ENTER to load default setting .

What photo, music and video formats are supported by this Multi-media Digital Photo Frame?	Photo: JPEG ,BMP,GIF Music: Mp3 ,WMA,WMV,OGG Video: AVI (bit rate under 30fps)
Does the player have a built-in memory?	Yes. The player has a 128MB internal memory to store media files . Don't rename the memory' s name.
Can I insert multiple memory cards?	Yes, you can insert one of SD,MMC, MS card each time.
Why doesn't the picture cover the entire screen?	The resolution of the picture to cover the entire screen must be greater than 320x240 pixels.
Can the DPF player connect with all computers?	No. The USB port of the PC must be USB 2.0 and the PC must have Windows 2000 or above.

## Troubleshooting

If you are having problems with your unit, please consult the troubleshooting guide below. Some simple checks or minor adjustments may restore proper operation.

### **No Power**

Ensure that you are pressing and holding the power button for at least 2 seconds.

Ensure the power outlet is operational

Ensure the power cord is not damaged

Ensure the power plug is connected firmly to the outlet.

### **Unit NOT working**

Turn the unit off and then on again.
